1. Variable name convention: Each item in the survey corresponds to a variable name in the data entry file. Each item number is preceded by the letter 'T' that indicates 'Teacher survey (vs. Youth or Parent). Therefore, variable name for item number 5 in the Teacher survey would be 'T05'. Please note that the variable item number is in two-digit format. All variable names are indicated in bold in place of the item numbers. Please note that there is only one section for this survey therefore no codes for sections.
