- Scroll through the Dataset queries section down to "Summary Measures of Mortality" -> Years of Potential Life Lost (YPLL) Before Age 75
- Find the following for Bernalillo County:
 - o YPLL per 100,000 population
 - Total Years of Population Life Lost
 - Number in the Population (person-years)

NM Drug Overdose Prevention Quarterly Measures Report:
