During the pandemic we had to figure out ways to reach our communities utilizing:

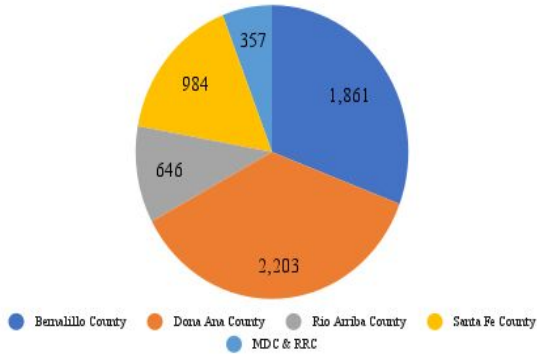
- Online Trainings

Although many organizations and businesses shut down we still managed to reach people from all over the state which ultimately made it easier for folks to attend.

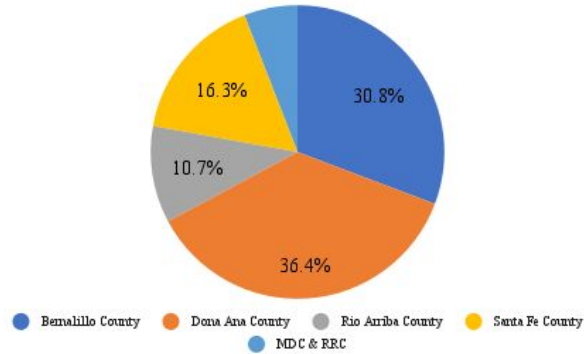

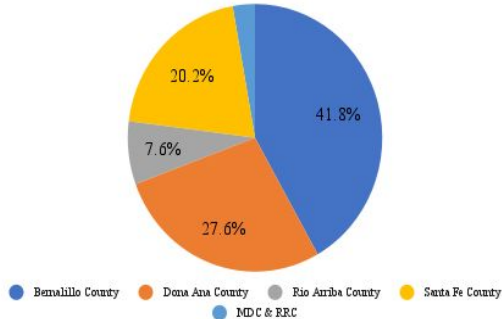
Total Number of People Trained using PDO Funds by Community



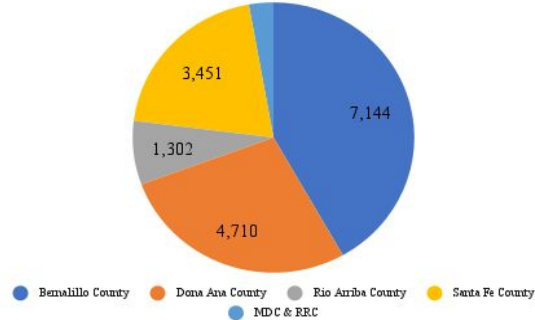
Training Distribution by PDO Funded Community



Distribution of Nasal Narcan Kits by PDO Funded Community



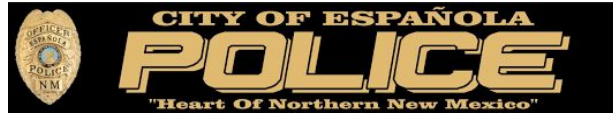
Total Number of PDO Funded Nasal Narcan Kits Distributed by Community



FY 20 - Prescription Drug Overdose: **257** individuals participated in **43** overdose prevention trainings and received **610** naloxone kits for personal use or for distribution to their clients PDO partner agencies reported **123** successful overdose reversals and were provided **84** replacement kits

FY 19 (PDO): **202** individuals participated in **25** overdose prevention trainings and received **386** naloxone kits for personal use or for distribution to their clients PDO partner agencies reported **40** successful overdose reversals and were provided **470** replacement kits

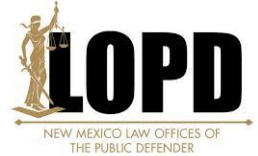
