

Cannabis Regulation Act

Personal Use

The following bullets are intended to assist you in knowing the law

Consuming

- Anyone 21 and older can legally: use (unless you are specifically not allowed to if on probation), possess, be under the influence of, transport, purchase, or display cannabis products.
- A person 21 or older can give it to anyone 21 and older (but can not sell it unless you have a license).
- A person can manufacture cannabis extract using nonvolatile solvents, alcohol or carbon dioxide or no solvents.
- A person is not allowed to smoke cannabis products in a public place (except in a licensed cannabis consumption area).
Penalty is a \$50 fine
- You can not drive under the influence of cannabis.



A person can have:

- up to 2 oz. of cannabis, 16 grams of cannabis extract and 800 milligrams of edible cannabis. More than this amount is a 4th degree felony.
- more than this limit if the excess is stored in their private residence and is not visible from a public place.
- up to 6 mature or immature cannabis plants per adult person. If there is more than one adult in the residence, they can have up to 12 plants total, but no more. (more than 12 is 4th degree felony)
- cannabis paraphernalia
- the odor of cannabis on them and not be suspected of a crime

People under 21

18-20 year olds:

- Possessing up to 6 mature or immature plants is a misdemeanor and subject to \$50 fine; more than 7-12 plants is a misdemeanor; more than 12 mature/immature plants 4th degree felony.

18 and younger:

- Can not possess or produce cannabis products, it is a civil violation.
- If found guilty of possession, required to attend a 4 hour evidence-based drug education and legal rights program at no cost to the minor and 4 hours of community service.
