- Merged with Health Council in early 2000s
  - (OSAP only Mainly Direct Service)
- Separate Coalition for Drug Free Communities grant Dine Ba Hozho Coalition
- CDWI met in conjunction with LDWI meetings

# CURRENT COALITION

- 2019 Health Council went through Strategic Planning Process & SJCP took on new prevention grants
- Added separate meetings
  - Opioid Overdose Prevention meeting
  - PFS19 Coalition
- 2020 Formed the Community Action Coalition
  - Funded streams: OSAP, CDWI, PFS19, PFS20, DOH Overdose Prevention

# WHY ONE COALITION

- Shorter meetings with workgroups as needed keeps people engaged and committed
- Members have limited time so don't have to choose which meeting to attend
- Can adapt and change as grant priorities change, as data changes
- Cohesive and comprehensive messages
- Reduce duplication
- Community focused
- Long term stability

# BALANCING MULTIPLE GRANT PRIORITIES

- Core Team
  - Staff from each grant
- Priority Areas for each grant with ability to collaborate on other projects
- Workgroups
  - Media
- Careful reporting and tracking of staff time

## MOVING FORWARD

- Community Coalition that is NOT grant focused but priority focused
- Adding community members to Core Team
- Adapt to changing needs and priorities within all of San Juan County
- Able to address larger scale prevention issues
